OPENER

Let's go around the room and share your name and your biggest childhood fear (start by sharing yours).

QUESTIONS

1. Why do those things cause us to fear?
2. How many of you have ever been afraid of a storm? What happened?
3. What does Psalm 46:1 tell us about God? (*God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.*)
4. The Psalmist is telling us that God is our refuge and strength no matter what we face. He is always ready to help in times of trouble. What are the extreme examples he gives in verses 2 and 3? How does that bring comfort to us?
5. In verse 10 God says, "Be still, and know that I am God!" Have you ever had to wait for something significant? What was it?
6. Why do you think waiting and being still and trusting God is so difficult?
7. Pray for students and any fears that they may have.
