



## Preschool Easter Activities

Thank you for coming to grab an Easter bag! We hope that as you celebrate Easter at home as a family, that you will be able to clearly share the story of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection in a meaningful way.

**Palm Sunday Activity** - *Supplies: green paper and a popsicle stick.*

Trace your child's hands and cut them out. Assemble and make a palm tree. Recite the scripture "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Matthew 21:9"



**Easter Egg Minute to Win it Games** – *Supplies: plastic Easter eggs and straws*

1. **Stacking egg halves.** How many towers can you make? Who can make the tallest tower in a minute?

4. **Matching halves.** How quickly can you put the eggs back together? How many can you do in the minute. Match colors or just the tops to bottoms.
5. **Egg relay.** Put one basket across the room and provide spoons to relay the eggs from basket to the next. Who can do the most in one minute!
6. **Easter egg transfer.** How many eggs can you transfer with a set of tongs from one basket to the other in one minute?

## Resurrection Rolls

**Resurrection Rolls**  
*Quick & Easy Recipe*  
{Using Crescent Roll Dough!}



### Ingredients:


- 1 pkg. canned crescent rolls
- Large marshmallows (1 per crescent roll)
- Melted butter
- Cinnamon and Sugar

Give each child a one marshmallow. It represents Jesus. Dip the marshmallow in melted butter, then the cinnamon sugar mixture. This represents the anointing oils and burial spices that were put on His body after he died.

Wrap the marshmallow in one triangle of dough. The represents the tomb where he was buried. Cook to directions on crescent roll packaging.

When you take a bite, you'll notice that the marshmallow is gone! Jesus is risen! He is alive!





# He is Risen Paper Plate Tomb Craft



## Supplies

Thick Paper Plate  
Gray Cardstock  
Standard and Jumbo Craft Sticks  
Gray Paint  
Printed Figures

## Instructions

1. Paint the back and front of the paper plate gray. Allow time to dry.
2. While the paper plate is drying. Print, cut out, and color the angel and Jesus.
3. Once the paper plate is dry, cut in half and cut out an opening on one paper plate half. Glue the paper plate halves together as shown.
4. Glue the paper Jesus and angel onto the paper plate tomb.
5. Glue the craft sticks into cross shapes and glue to the tomb as shown.
6. Lightly spray the gray cardstock with water on both sides and form into a rock shape. The water makes it easier to crinkle and will hold its form better. Allow time for your craft to dry.
