6. According to Philippians 2:5-11, Jesus humbled Himself by coming to Earth. How do you respond to that action of Christ?
7. Through faith in Jesus, Christ's sacrifice on the cross leads to some important truths about our identity. Scripture says that we are made holy and righteous and that we are loved. Which truth do you identify with most and why?
