1. What did you know about the Trinity (God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit) before today? What do you know now?
2. What does it mean to you that the Gospel can be both fantastically simple and super deep all at the same time?
3. Read Isaiah 45:5-6. What statement does God make about Himself? Why is His statement significant and important to our faith?
4. Read Genesis 1:26-27. How do these verses from the Creation story point to the nature of the Trinity?
5. Read Matthew 3:16-17. How do these verses from Jesus' baptism point to the nature of the Trinity?
6. Why is it important for us to consider the Trinity when we go about living the Christian life?
7. How does knowing God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit impact our faith?
